

General essay questions

All scholarship applicants submitting an application for the Statewide Student Aid Program, Career Aid for Technical Students, Adult Student Aid Program and the Winthrop L. & Bernice Perry Scholarship must answer the following two questions in order to be considered for a scholarship:

1. Please describe your educational and career goals.

Maximum length: 600 words

2. Please list any personal, financial or family circumstances that you would like us to know about as we consider your application.

Maximum length: 300 words

Additional essay questions for the Winthrop L. & Bernice Perry Scholarship

If you live in Wilton, Milford or Lyndeborough, NH you are eligible for the Winthrop L. & Bernice Blake Perry scholarship. To be considered for this scholarship, you must complete three additional essay questions:

 Describe a person who embodies the idea of excellence you try to carry for yourself. This person might be a role model, an historical figure or even a fictional hero - someone who you are inspired by and admire beyond your family members.

Maximum length: 600 words

2. Describe what you hope to achieve in the next step in your education. What do you imagine this next step will be like? How does it relate to your previous education and life experience? How does the educational program you are now pursuing fit with your personal and/or career goals.

Maximum length: 600 words

3. If there is something you excel in, please describe it. It might be academic, artistic, athletic, social, or another area.

Maximum length: 600 words
