- 1. Review for completeness
- 2. Local Grants Committee approves or declines
- 3. Applicants notified within 3 months of applying

LARGE GRANTS PROGRAM

\$20,001 - \$300,000

2-STEP REVIEW PROCESS


- 1. Staff due diligence
- 2. Advisory committee invites full application or declines within 3 months
- 3. Applicant submits full application and work plan
- 4. Advisory Committee makes award or decline decision within 2 months

REVIEW CRITERIA

- Have engaged youth (ages <22) in design, implementation, and decision making process of project/organization
- Demonstrate how initiative is reducing barriers to participation
- For requests more than \$5,000,
 demonstrate long-term, regional impact

REVIEW PROCESS

- 1. Review for completeness
- 2. Empower Coös Youth Grants Committee approves or declines

3. Applicants notified within 3 months of applying
