Amoskeag Health

To improve integrated health care services for low-income, uninsured/underinsured women aged 65+ years.

Community Action Program Belknap-Merrimack Counties

To sustain in-home services for frail older women in Greater Manchester through volunteer efforts.

Community Caregivers of Greater Derry

To provide volunteer caregiving services to women aged 65+ living in Londonderry, NH.

Easter Seals NH

To provide care coordination and emergency financial assistance for vulnerable, low-income women 65 and older living in Greater Manchester.

Manchester Housing and Redevelopment Authority

To provide supportive services including meals, housekeeping, laundry and service coordination to low income elderly women.

NH Catholic Charities

To help Manchester's senior women with food, transportation and social interaction.

NH Legal Assistance, Concord

To provide free legal services low-income women aged 65 and older in the Mary Gale service area and engage in outreach and education to ensure that they receive the legal help they need.

Organization for Refugee and Immigrant Success

To provide culturally and linguistically-appropriate care coordination, health education, and case management for older refugee women in the Manchester area.

St. Joseph Community Services

To reduce hunger and isolation among low-income older and/or women who are disabled in the Greater Manchester area.

To provide enhanced housing services for low income senior women, facilitating access to safer, more affordable housing, and assisting with resources needed to remain securely housed.

To provide elder immigrant and refugee women in the greater Manchester area with socialization, care coordination, educational and informative experiences, and access to other community resources.
