In September, 2022 the Tillotson Donor Advised Fund Committee made 15 grants totaling \$271,600. Grant awards were made to the following organizations:

Coös Economic Development Corporation, Lancaster, NH received \$20,000 to support four pop-up businesses over three months in Coös County.

Episcopal Diocese of New Hampshire, Concord, NH received \$12,000 to continue supporting the weekend BackPack program for five Coös County elementary schools.

Garderie Le Petit Moulin, Saint Malo, Quebec received \$20,000 to provide operating support.

Lunenburg, Gilman, and East Concord Senior Citizens, Inc. Gilman, VT received \$20,000 to renovate the Senior Center building including kitchen, bathrooms and meeting space.

NH Teen Institute for Prevention of Alcohol & Other Drug Abuse Inc. Manchester, NH received \$20,000 to provide scholarships for Coös high school and middle school students to attend leadership development programs.

North Country Alliance for Balanced Change, Littleton, NH received \$20,000 to provide operating support focused on community education, legal and research expenses.

North Country Charter Academy, Littleton, NH received \$20,000 to provide a weekly STEM-based program to at-risk high school students.

Ressourcerie des Frontieres, Coaticook, Quebec received \$18,600 to support 8 community-engaged artistic projects as part of the organization's 10th anniversary celebrations.
