2022 Wellborn Ecology Fund Grants

Cornish Elementary School was awarded \$5,000 to improve accessibility and expand the use of an outdoor learning space for Pre-K through Grade 8 students.

Enfield Village School was awarded \$5,000 to create a permanent outdoor classroom space.

John Hay Estate at the Fells was awarded \$5,000 to enhance ecology education programming for schools, youth and families in the Upper Valley region.

Linking Lands Alliance was awarded \$4,827 to support the Scientific Maps Go to School Project to increase awareness of wildlife habitat needs and scientific literacy in Upper Valley schools.

Marion Cross School was awarded \$3,172 to support K-6 learning and exploration of their local environment using classroom microscopes.

The Vermont Center for Ecostudies was awarded \$7,000 to support the Community Science Teacher Education Program for Upper Valley educators.

White River Partnership was awarded \$5,000 to engage 21 Upper Valley schools in classroom and field work activities that create opportunities for hands-on, place-based ecology education in the White River watershed.
